MARLBOROUGH

Marlborough is New Zealand's premier wine growing region located in the north-eastern tip of the South Island. Reputed as one of the top viticultural areas in the world, Sauvignon Blanc from Marlborough is known for its extraordinary purity, bright acidity and wet stone minerality.

VINEYARD

Our 2014 Sauvignon Blanc is comprised of 85% Wairau Valley and 15% Awatere Valley fruit. The Wairau Valley contributes vibrant aromatics and a flurry of tropical fruit characters. The Awatere Valley adds the crisp acidity and distinct minerality that put Marlborough Sauvignon Blancs on the map.

This wine is a textbook Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Aromas of freshly cut grass and gooseberry are met with a pallet of fresh lemon, grapefruit and a full dose of passionfruit on the finish. Enjoy nicely chilled.
